Job Duties

- Fosters a positive, professional presence with the community.
- Collects and compiles data as needed ie: surveys, attendance etc.
- Prioritizes scheduled meetings with THRIVE and Life's Choices' teams.
- Prep and practice lessons with THRIVE staff and regularly review lesson scripts.
- Completes classroom log survey after each class.
- Excellent communication skills and naturally engages with teens.
- Complies with the policies and procedures of any grants.
- Other duties as assigned.
